

MAP DISPLAY

Quick Start Guide

Find pertinent information easily, from the home page and Pathway Pages:

Search by Keywords:

- Enter one or more medical or lay terms into the search box on the title bar, and click go or use your Enter key
- View the Map of Medicine relevant results tab, or switch tabs to view information drawn from the National Library for Health.
- Transfer your search directly to external sources, by selecting a radio button.



Browse by Area:

- Select a broad area of medicine from the first menu, and open up a range of Specialties.
- Select a Specialty, and open a range of Pathways (a patient journey).
- Select a Pathway to reveal Pages, and
- Select a Page, and click to view.

Additional navigation tools on the home page are:





Search by Clinical Presentation:

- Enter a symptom or a clinical presentation, and filter the list of Pages by partial or full terms.

View Recent:

- Revisit Pages you've already viewed, in this or previous Map sessions.


Once you've accessed a Page, navigate through it, and view information using icons and links.

- Double click  to open the Quick Info Panel to view evidence-based clinical information, including images and attachments.
- Double click  on a node to view or add Local Administrative information.
- Double click  on a node to view or add Personal Notes.
- Open a Referral letter by double clicking .
- Select the Print button to print a PDF version of a Page. This includes a visual image of the page, clinical evidence, references, attachments, local admin info, and your choice of with or without your personal notes.

View evidence and further information by selecting the link from the bottom right corner of any Page. Included are:

- Key dates for that Page's information
- Certifications awarded
- Evidence grades, and the Nodes they pertain to
- Clickable References supporting the Page.

Navigate your way through the Map of Medicine by:

- Reopening the Browse by Area tool, without losing your current Page, by clicking 
- Reopening the Browse by Area tool by clicking on any section of the bread crumb trail.
- Following a guided path through the care journey by selecting 'Go to' Nodes to transfer to other Pages in the Map of Medicine.
- Searching from the box on the title bar of any Page.
- Searching the National Library for Health from the Quick Info Panel on any Node.
- Returning to your most recently viewed Page with the 'Back to' link on every screen.

Utilise administrative options to adapt the Map of Medicine to local protocols:

- Manage Local Administrative Information via the Quick Info Panel on every Page.
- View and print Local Admin Info reports through the Admin report link on every screen.
- Manage Local Referral Letters and view and print Usage reports via the Referral Letters button.
- Review Feedback, with locally-selected Feedback reviewers, by clicking the Feedback button or link, available on every screen.
